**Notice of a Special Election
for One Trustee**

Notice is hereby given that an Election for one Trustee of the Municipal Employees', Officers', and Officials' Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago (Fund), will be held on Friday, September 23, 2011, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. at our **Office located at 321 North Clark Street, Chicago, Illinois.**

Any employee participant who holds a position by Certification and appointment as a result of a competitive civil service examination as distinguished from temporary appointment for a period of not less than 5 years prior to the date of election or so holds a position which is not exempt from the classified or the personnel ordinance by a city that adopted a career service ordinance is eligible to become a Candidate for Trustee.

An eligible employee participant, as above described, who is desirous of becoming a Candidate at this Election for the term indicated below may obtain the Rules of Election, a Candidate Affidavit and a Nominating Petition from the Executive Director of the Fund, Suite 700, 321 North Clark Street, Chicago, Illinois 60654 on or after Friday, September 2, 2011, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:30 P.M.

Each Affidavit must be signed by the Candidate named therein and must include a Nominating Petition bearing the endorsement of at least seventy-five (75) employee participants of the Fund, and must be filed with the Executive Director of the Fund, Suite 700, 321 North Clark Street, Chicago, Illinois on any day from Tuesday, September 6, 2011 to and including Friday, September 9, 2011, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:30 P.M.

Said Election shall be by ballot and will be conducted under rules adopted by the Retirement Board, as required under law. All employee participants in the Fund at the time such Election is held are entitled to vote at this Election.
