## Discussion of Issues Related to 40 ILCS 5/1-109.1(10)

Mr. Lopez discussed with the Board 40 ILCS 5/1-109.1(10):

As of January 1, 2016, it is the aspirational goal for a retirement system, pension fund, or investment board subject to this Code to use emerging investment managers for not less than 20% of the total funds under management. Furthermore, it shall be the aspirational goal that not less than 20% of investment advisors be minorities, females, and persons with disabilities as those terms are defined in the Business Enterprise for Minorities, Females, and Persons with Disabilities Act. It shall be the aspirational goal to utilize businesses owned by minorities, females, and persons with disabilities for not less than 20% of contracts awarded for "information technology services", "accounting services", "insurance brokers", "architectural and engineering services", and "legal services" as those terms are defined in the Act.

The aspirational goals reflected in the law are normally met or exceeded by the Fund.
