Following the presentation, Fund Counsel recommended that the Fund object to paying any additional fees to Newport Capital and redirect the limited ongoing services to legal counsel as the investment has been

One question was raised with respect to whether the fees paid to Newport are the "in total" fees being earned or just represent the MEABF's portion of the fees. Small Cap Value Search Update

Mr. Wesner updated the Board on the status of this search and noted that the Fund had received 49 responses of which 10 respondent firms were Illinois based and 4 respondent firms were MWDBE firms.
